US Senator Patrick Leahy, D-VT, announces a \$9.9 million Homeland Security contract to NUARI to continue work on DECIDE, software designed to support the nation's financial sector.

NUARI runs Quantum Dawn II with 50 organizations and 500 participants in the financial sector, the only cyber threat exercise of its kind.

NU Center for Advanced Computing and Digital Forensics is created.

NUARI and US Senator Patrick Leahy, D-VT, announce a \$15 million contract, of which \$6 million is awarded through the Air Force Research Lab in Rome, NY, to fund research to develop Web*DECIDE, a war gaming platform for the financial sector.

CACDF

NU is one of six universities in the nation to officially partner with the United States Army Reserves (USAR) to develop cyber-education curricula that aligns with federal standards and cybersecurity needs, leading a USAR public/private partnership effort, called Cyber P3, in an effort to foster the intellectual development of future leaders.

The 302nd Information Operations Battalion Web OpSec detachment, a U.S. Army Reserve detachment, forms on the Norwich campus.

NUARI runs Quantum Dawn III with over 80 financial institutions and government organizations in the largest financial sector cybersecurity exercise in the nation.

Norwich University is named one of eight colleges by the US Department of Defense Cybercrime Center (DC3) as a pilot university of the Center of Digital Forensic Academic Excellence (CDFAE) program. The program is designed to partner academia with government in an effort to establish standards for digital forensic education.

NUARI runs Quantum Dawn I, the largest critical infrastructure cyber threat exercise with the financial sector.

The Norwich computer security and information assurance (CSIA) program was the only educational institution invited to support Santa Clara Police Department, the lead law enforcement agency at Super Bowl 50, and the law enforcement and homeland security functions leading up to and during this international sporting event.

Norwich's MSISA is ranked #3 as one of the top ten best cybersecurity graduate programs in the country by Universities.com.
